Job Summary

This staff person will be a member of the Children, Youth, and Family (CYF) Ministry Team, which works collectively to implement the elements of worship, outreach, learning, fellowship, and leadership development to teach and develop faith in a way that is consistent with the mission and vision of Gloria Dei. This person will work directly with youth, young adults, parents, other adults, and staff, doing hands-on ministry and training others to share in this ministry.

Essential Functions.

- 1. Senior High Ministry (9th 12th grade) 65%
 - Collaboratively work with CYF staff to set the strategy and vision for high school youth ministry at Gloria Dei
 - Recruit, develop and train a leadership team to help plan and implement high school youth programming and outreach
 - Plan and lead weekly (Wed nights) ministry gatherings
 - Develop and implement youth leadership training and opportunities
 - Plan and lead summer mission trips
 - Plan, develop, and lead fundraising to support ministry opportunities.
 - Communicate with students and families through print, digital, and social media
 - Have a ministry of presence to youth and their families on Sunday mornings
- 2. Middle School Ministry (6th-8th grade) 25%
 - Collaboratively work with CYF staff to set the strategy and vision for middle school youth ministry at Gloria Dei
 - Recruit, develop and train a leadership team to help plan and implement middle school youth programming and outreach
 - Participate in Wednesday night planning and programming
 - Plan and oversee a ministry that transitions youth from middle to high school
 - Provide and supervise ministry leadership opportunities for youth
 - Plan, promote, and coordinate summer camp opportunities
- 3. College Aged Ministry 10%
 - Identify, train, and supervise college students to be Youth Assistants with the High School Ministry.
 - Facilitate Campus Contacts
 - Identify and train a group of volunteers to keep students connected to Gloria Dei
 - Interface with Tre Ministries

Other Responsibilities

- Attend and participate in staff meetings.
- As a member of the CYF team, participate and contribute to the overall mission and vision of the CYF Ministry.
- Administrative and database management that pertains to ministry area

Qualifications

- A Bachelor's Degree or equivalent
- 3 years of ministry experience in a church or other similar field
- Demonstrated leadership skills
- A mature faith

Core Competencies

- **Self-Differentiation:** Demonstrates strong and appropriate personal boundaries in relationships; has a healthy appreciation of self, without being egotistical; is emotionally mature; can maintain a non-anxious presence in the midst of turmoil; not overly dependent upon outside affirmation; works to build a strong personal support system.
- **Personal Resilience:** Can effectively cope with change and uncertainty; can shift gears comfortably; can decide and act without having the total picture; isn't upset when things are up in the air; can comfortably handle risk and uncertainty; is flexible.
